

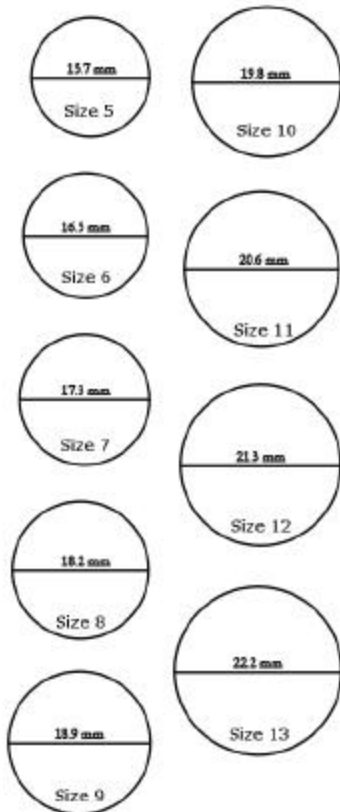
DiamondsRight.com -- How to find your ring size

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Option #1

Take a ring that you know fits the correct finger. Place it over the circles below, until you find the circle that matches the *inside* of the ring. If you're between sizes, use the larger size.



Option #2

Find or make a piece of paper about 6 inches long and ¼ inch wide. Wrap it snugly around the base of the correct finger and mark the point of overlap. Make sure your paper "ring" will fit over the knuckle on that finger as well. Now compare the mark on your paper to the lines below, picking the line which is *at least as long as* the mark you've made.



If it's a surprise, or you don't have access to the intended finger, you can take a ring that fits the intended finger and slip it over a candle. Mark the candle where the ring sits comfortably and measure that circumference instead.

Other Ring-Sizing Tips

1. If possible, make your measurements when your fingers are warm and at the end of the day.
2. For wide bands, move up a ring size; this will add comfort to the fit.
3. The average ring size for women is about 6; for men, the average ring size is about 10.
